Christian Duville has been appointed Deputy Chief Executive Officer of LCL Le Crédit Lyonnais.

Mr Duville, 56 years old, has a degree in political science and a masters in law. He has been a director of Crédit Lyonnais since 2003, and was previously Chief Executive Officer of Caisse Régionale de Crédit Agricole d'Aquitaine. Mr Duville will join LCL on 15 September 2005, and will be part of the Executive Committee chaired by Georges Pauget, LCL's Chief Executive Officer.

In particular, Mr Duville's duties will include the implementation of the business plan and the deployment of LCL's new commercial position.
